

## Call for members of the OBESSU Pool of Trainers

Deadline for application: **13<sup>th</sup> of December 2017, 23:59 CET**

The OBESSU Pool of Trainers is a group of experienced trainers, educators and facilitators with insight in the world of OBESSU and school student activism. Members of the Pool of Trainers will be involved in the pedagogical and peer education work of OBESSU, under which we understand not only OBESSU events, preparatory meetings, follow-up and evaluation event, but also being active in the OBESSU PoT online platform. Members of the OBESSU Pool of Trainers will also have the chance to be involved as external expert in events organised by OBESSU Member, Candidate and Affiliate Organisations.

**The new members of the Pool of Trainers will be chosen for a two-years mandate for 2018-2019.** That means, as of 2018 PoT will function with an overlapping mandate, with current PoT members being active 2017-2018.

Please note that a mandate in the OBESSU Pool of Trainers is not a political mandate.

### Selection criteria

The applicants are expected to:

- Be experienced in OBESSU and OBESSU events;
- Be interested in the topics OBESSU works with;
- Have a specific expertise in the following fields: global citizenship; active participation; human rights; education for democratic citizenship; youth policy; youth social and economic rights; gender issues; ICT; organisational development.
- Have previous experience in training/facilitation and a great interest in pedagogy and non-formal education;
- Be comfortable to work in English and with multicultural groups; other languages would be an asset;
- Be willing to attend also external training and educational event as participant;
- Be available to travel in Europe for OBESSU activities, and to deliver remote work.

**We encourage participants of all genders to apply!**

Candidates for the Pool of Trainers do not need to submit a Nomination letter from an OBESSU Member, Candidate and Affiliate Organisation, and several people coming from the same organisational can run for the Pool of Trainers.

Selected trainers are expected to **be active on the online OBESSU PoT Platform** (Basecamp), sharing with other trainer colleagues information, pedagogical material, training opportunities, thus contributing to the PoT learning community.
