

Call for Working Group Members of the OBESSU AFC and Statutes Revision

Deadline to apply: 27th of September 23:59 CEST

OBESSU has opened the call for members of the Working Group on the OBESSU Annual Financial Contribution (AFC) and Statutes Revision. The Working Group will work alongside the OBESSU Board to revise the OBESSU Annual Financial Contribution and the OBESSU Statutes. The Working Group will consist of representatives from OBESSU Member Organisations, Candidate Members, and Affiliate Members.

Aims and Tasks of the Working Group

As a member of the Working Group you will contribute to:

- Revising the OBESSU Annual Financial Contribution and bringing the views of the OBESSU Membership to the forefront of the discussion.
- Creating a proposal for the AFC for the General Assembly 2024
- Studying and revising the OBESSU Statutes to pinpoint any changes necessary, & to propose a transition from Statutes to a Internal Regulations + Governing Statutes (to allow OBESSU to legally amend our current statutes in any country).
- A discussion and research project, into launching an OBESSU Solidarity Fund, including its funding, governance, and need.
- Proposing any necessary changes of the OBESSU Statutes to the GA 2024 so that the OBESSU Statutes may better reflect the working reality and vision of OBESSU

Commitment and Timeline

The Working Group will divide its tasks internally, and will mainly communicate online through emails and online meetings. An ability to work both in a team and to take the initiative as an individual is desired.

The mandate of the working group will last from September 2023 to July 2024.

The selection will be made and communicated by the 29th of September.

The first online meeting of the Working Group will be held the week of October 2nd.

There will be an in-person meeting of this working group to be held before the COMEM 2023.
